## WHAT IS HOMESHARE?

HomeSharing is about sharing the space you already have in your home with someone who is looking for affordable housing, a HomeSeeker. In exchange for reduced rental costs the HomeSeeker agrees to provide 5-7 hours a week contributing to the dynamics of your home. This could include sharing a meal together, helping with chores, yard work or walking a pet.

## HOW DOES THE TORONTO HOMESHARE PROJECT WORK?

Someone will work with you to facilitate the matching process. They will gather information about you, the space you have to offer and help you to decide what goals and expectations you have for being involved in the HomeShare Pilot Project. It's important to remember that you, as the HomeOwner, will always have the final say in who might be sharing your home.
