WHAT IS HOMESHARE?

- The Toronto HomeShare Pilot Project matches older adults who would like to provide a room in their home to a student.
- The aim of the Toronto HomeShare Pilot Project is to increase the pool of affordable housing options for students and also to support older adults.

HOW DOES HOMESHARE WORK?

- Home providers list their homes, and are matched to students who apply to the program.
- It is a 'facilitated' process and a trained social worker will assist both the home provider and student every step of the way.
- In exchange for lower rent, students offer to contribute to the shared home.
